

## **EBS Alumni Abroad Scholarship**

### **EBS Alumni Arnd Schikowsky Award**

In memory of our friend and fellow classmate Arnd Schikowsky we have chosen to initiate the Arnd Schikowsky Award.

Arnd Schikowsky was a student of the EBS from 2000 to 2003. During his semester abroad at the Katz Graduate School of Business (University of Pittsburgh, USA), Arnd contracted cancer. Following a relentless fight, Arnd Schikowsky has lost his battle to cancer on August 24, 2003 in his hometown of Hamburg, Germany at the age of 25. Arnd was an exceptionally engaged, driven, intelligent and supportive classmate. He is survived by his parents and a huge circle of friends and family, who learned to understand that life is the most unique gift we are granted with every moment of it being worth living to the fullest.

Following the initiative of his friends and classmates Arndt Völkle (EBS Diploma 2004) and Peter Holzer (EBS Diploma 2004) have cooperated relentlessly with the EBS Alumni to implement the EBS Alumni Arnd Schikowsky Award. The Award entitles two students of the EBS Business School (one Bachelor's and one Master's degree student) to the Award's endorsement, valued at a one-time scholarship of Euro 500,-.

### **EBS Alumni Martin Krämer Award**

During his time at the EBS, it was a partial scholarship of the EBS Alumni allowing the young Martin Krämer to successfully complete his studies and initiate a successful professional career. Ever since his time at the EBS, Martin was greatly appreciative of the international focus, the high expectations and the professional orientation of the education process.

On October 19, 2000, a car accident took Martin Krämer's life. He was survived by his wife and best friend Louise – whom he had met during his semester abroad in Shanghai – and his two daughters Sophie and Laura.

Upon initiative of his family and his business partner André Peto (EBS Diploma 1990), a charitable trust to the support of EBS students has been established. The Award entitles

two students of the EBS Business School (one Bachelor's and one Master's degree student) to the Awards endorsement, valued at a one-time scholarship of Euro 2,500,-.

### **EBS Alumni Law Abroad Award**

With the establishment of the EBS Law School the first Law School student has been supported for his semester abroad in 2013. To endorse the students of the Law School, the EBS Alumni has established the EBS Alumni Abroad Award.

Anually since 2013, the Award entitles one student of the Law School who has shown exceptional academic performance to the Awards endorsement, valued at a one-time scholarship of Euro 2,500,-.
